Q: Is there a possibility of zip-up hoodies or uniform tops made of alternate materials?

A: After speaking with McCarthy Uniforms and CBE Procurement, it is possible that we can select alternate uniform pieces in the future based upon data and feedback obtained in the first few purchasing windows.

Q: What does 'support' for needy families look like, as mentioned in earlier communications?

A: Please reach out to Mr. Radder directly if you have questions or concerns about the financial impact of uniform purchases for your family. There is financial support offered by our School Council. We are very thankful for their commitment to equity in our learning community.

Q: What logo or graphical work was used on the uniforms?

A: The logo used for the uniforms is the same as that designed last year and documented in the Visual Identity story on the Riverside School website, <u>available here</u>. There is a sample swatch of the embroidery available in the Main Office if you wish to see it.

Q: What are the expectations regarding uniform use for next year?

A: Students enrolled at Riverside School are expected to wear a uniform top, as provided by McCarthy Uniforms, each day, Monday through Thursday. Any of the uniform tops available for purchase will be acceptable each day.

Q: Are we still having free Friday?

A: Yes, 'Free Friday' will still be a practice at Riverside School moving forward. That said, when 'special occasions' at school fall on a Friday, it is possible students will be asked to wear a uniform item that day. We will be sure to communicate this in advance so there is as little confusion as possible.

Q: What will be the uniform policy for Grade 8 and 9?

A: The uniform policy for Grade 8 and 9 students will be the same as for all other students in the school.
